School Fund Criteria

Below is the criteria that should be used to determine candidates for the Leonore Annenberg School Fund for Children

- Must be an elementary school
- Must have *at least* 90% of students enrolled in the free and reduced lunch program
- Must identify a need that will benefit every student DIRECTLY
- Must complete an application and must be willing to provide a point person at the school who can assist with expediting grant related paperwork in a timely fashion and meet deadlines for required submitted material
- Must be a stable school with no chance of being restructured or closed in the foreseeable future
- Intermediary organization must get a keen sense of the quality and stability of the school leadership as well as the quality and stability of the teaching staff
- Grant amount should be no more than \$100,000

Please note that the schools do not have to match funds. There is no matching component to this program.

School Nominations

Each school nomination must consist of the following elements

- completed application (by the school)
- completed at a glance form (by the nominating organization)
- site visit summary
- photos of school
- back-up documentation verifying # of students on Free and reduced lunch programs
