### A Piece of History

In 1938, Mrs. Jennie Lincoln founded the Northside Club for Boys in order to help boys in the community who came from special circumstances. For ten years, programming was conducted in the basement of the Community Building on Commercial Street. Recognizing the importance of the movement to help youth, Mrs. Lincoln visited the national headquarters of Boys Clubs of America in New York City in the 1940s. It was her long time ambition to have the Springfield Club associated with that national organization. Mrs. Lincoln's wish was fulfilled when a charter was granted on April 15, 1946. A little over a year later construction started at the Henderson Unit on 1300 Boonville.

Mrs. Lincoln passed away in 1945
